EXPLANATORY NOTES

As a result of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1160 amendment extends the expiry date for authorisations for products containing potassium hydrogen carbonate with the exception of authorisations already made subject to a phased withdrawal. To minimise divergence in product authorisations in GB and NI, HSE has extended the affected products to reflect the earlier NI dates only.
